**Hernando County, Fla.** — The Florida Department of Health in Hernando County (DOH-Hernando) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels the following location:

Tests completed on Tuesday, March 31, 2026, indicate that the water quality at Alfred McKethan Pine Island shows an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines.
